Nose

Sweet red apples, strawberries and blossoms.

Palate

Super delicate aromatics tied to a succulent acid profile like a crunchy crisp apple. There's plenty of complexity underpinning the profile and a mineral texture that's very inviting.

Pair

Chili prawn pasta or a creamy burrata with heirloom tomatoes.

Winemaking

Harvested by hand. Crushed and chilled directly into the press. Gentle pressing cycle. Naturally fermented in tank. No MLF. Matured for 3 months on lees.

Vineyard

McLaren Flat, McLaren Vale Grenache, unknown clone on own roots. 180m - 200m elevation with a NW aspect. Reddish clay loam over sandstone soil. VSP spur pruned on permanent cordon.
