Nose

Melon, brioche and a touch of dried grass.

Palate

Presenting itself powerfully at first, the viscosity slowly gives way to a lively acidity and fuller mouthfeel, punctuated by soft fruit and spicier undertones.

Pair

Chips and Gravy.

Winemaking

Hand picked in the morning. Whole bunch pressed to barrel. 60% new French oak barriques. Wild fermented, full and spontaneous MLF. Aged on lees for 2 years, aged for a further 2 years in seasoned oak.

Vineyard

Bonoposto Vineyard, Kenton Valley B95 and I10V1 Clones planted on own roots. 500m Elevation, North Easterly Aspect. Light loam over sandstone VSP spur pruned with multiple foliage wires. Shoot and bunch thinned.
