Nose

White blossoms, mineral spice and gooseberry.

Palate

Lean and tight, it builds subtle generosity through the middle that gets sucked back in to flow into the bright acid line through the finish.

Pair

Scallops in butter or delicious grilled asparagus spears.

Winemaking

Picked in the cool morning. Gently pressed to stainless. Fermented at cool temperatures. Racked off lees early. Matured in stainless. No MLF.

Vineyard

Paracombe Vineyards, Paracombe. Unknown Clone planted on own roots. 410m-420m elevation, Southerly aspect. Loam with ironstone gravel over quartz. VSP Spur pruned with foliage wires.
