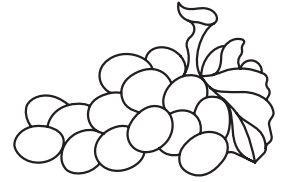


ALPHA BOX & DICE



From the grape of Jove, this is a specialised vinous find; full of good humour. So quench your thirst and mood - drink from Jupiter's cup.

VINTAGE	2015
VARIETY	SANGIOVESE: 79% CABERNET SAUVIGNON: 21%
REGION	BAROSSA MCLAREN VALE



LOOKS LIKE	Burgundy with a dash of bourbon.
SMELLS LIKE	Cassis and rich earth, sour cherries, cranberries, bourbon and clove spice.
TASTES LIKE	The 'Manhattan of Wine': Maraschino cherries, whisky-style oak, complex bitters, black olives.
DRINK WITH	Juicy rare steak.
CELLAR FOR	Up to 20 years.
NUMBERS	ALCOHOL: 14.5% pH: 3.51g/L RESIDUAL SUGAR: 2g/L TOTAL ACIDITY: 6.19g/L
VINEYARD	SANGIOVESE: Day Vineyards, Mt Crawford. CABERNET SAUVIGNON: Harnett's Vineyard, Willunga.
SOIL	SANGIOVESE: Loam over sandstone. CABERNET SAUVIGNON: Black grey loam.
FERMENTATION	Inoculated with a neutral yeast, crushed and destemmed; fermented until dry on skins for two weeks.
MATURATION	24 months in old and new barriques and puncheons. 20% new oak, 20% puncheons. Aged on lees for 18 months.
STYLE	It might not be a technical DOC wine classification, but the Super Tuscan is a sight to behold. Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon, making peace between the Italians and the French.
