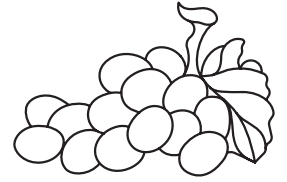

LOOKS LIKE	Gold with a touch of bronze.
SMELLS LIKE	Nashi pears and apples.
TASTES LIKE	Bright, fine acid, floral and approachable.
DRINK WITH	Good company, great in a Spritz.
CELLAR FOR	Drink now!
NUMBERS	ALCOHOL: 11% pH: 3.08 RESIDUAL SUGAR: 6.6g/L TOTAL ACIDITY: 6.24g/L
VINEYARD	Frasca Vineyard, Murray Darling.
SOIL	Red sand-loam over limestone.
FERMENTATION	Machine picked early, oxidatively handled, destemmed, light pressing cycle, inoculated with a neutral yeast; fermented until dry.
MATURATION	Six months in tank with weekly lees stirring.
STYLE	Prosecco. The fresh, dry thirst quencher - perfect to sip in the sun. Kightly sparkling and perfect on its own or in a cocktail/Spritz. Enjoy by glass, bottle, or litre.

Zaptung has found its home as a staple sparkling white wine - the base of any good cocktail, the drink of choice to cheers to a good night. We once told people the bubbles got in the wine when lightning struck the tank... the story stuck!
