Nose
Summer berries, warm spices and autumn forest.

Palate
Initially bright and juicy, followed by dark, exotic spices that flesh out the presence on the palate to finish clean, fresh and with a defined structure.

Pair
Veal saltimbocca or stuffed mushrooms.

Winemaking
Hand picked, 90% destemmed with 10% whole bunch fermentation. Naturally fermented, on skins for 2 weeks. Gently plunged twice daily. Basket pressed and matured in seasoned barrique and puncheons for 6 months. Full and spontaneous MLF.

Vineyard
Serendipity Vineyard, Adelaide Hills. 115, D5V12, Abel and MV6 clones planted on own roots. 400-420m elevation, E aspect. Sandy-loam over clay. VSP Spur pruned with foliage wires.

This Wendy echoes her namesake from Peter Pan, and despite the pretty exterior, there's a depth and quiet strength to this wine.
