Nose

Cassis and rich earth, sour cherries, cranberries, bourbon and clove spice.

Palate

The "Manhattan of wine", Maraschino cherries, whiskey style oak, complex bitters, chewy Cabernet tannins and black olives.

Pair

Juicy rare steak.

Winemaking

Crushed and de-stemmed. 24 months in old and new barriques and puncheons. 20% new oak, about 20% puncheons. Aged on lees for 18 months. Sangiovese - loam over sandstone. Cabernet Sauvignon - black grey loam.

Vineyard

Sangiovese from Day Vineyards at Mt Crawford, Barossa Valley. Cabernet Sauvignon from Harnett Vineyard in McLaren Vale

"What once was glittering rubies in the glass, is now a rich garnet. An aged beauty, enriched and complex after 9 years ageing in the cellar. Carried by a linear acidity and staunch structure, juicy summer fruits have dried and caramelised, warm baking spices have risen to the foreground and a lingering earthiness stands in good stead alongside softened tannins. Drink from Jupiter's cup."
