### Vineyard

Whisson Lake Vineyard, Adelaide Hills.

### Nose

Bright sour cherries, dark berries and exotic spices, with fresh summer rain squeezed out of the forest floor.

### Palate

Ethereal and satin smooth like luxury bed sheets, velvety tannins supported by an energetic acidity that draws out the palate far into the future.

### Pair

Crispy skin duck breast or a rare cheeseburger.

### Winemaking

Hand harvested and layered into the same fermenter: 1/3rd whole bunch, 1/3rd footstomped for an hour, 1/3rd destemmed. Gently hand plunged twice daily. Basket pressed with pressings and free run combined. Aged in seasoned barriques for 12 months. Aged in bottle for a further 10 months.
