

"For a wine traditionally overt in its opulence, the 2021 celebrates a subtle, elegant and nuanced rendition. There's richness, sure, but whole bunch fermentation adds layers of complexity that support the more brooding destemmed component. A lick of spicy new French oak gets lapped up by the fruit, integrating with the darker spectrum of savoury flavour. It's a slight deviation from the classic but a Shiraz that truly gets me excited, being a more elegant expression of the variety."

Nose

Dark cherries and chocolate, exotic spices and cedar.

Palate

A velvety smooth structure and soft fruits intertwined with spice, held together with a tight acidity that promises this wine will age gracefully.

Pair

Steak with red wine jus or stuffed mushrooms.

Winemaking

Handpicked in the morning. 50% Whole bunch fermentation, 50% destemmed. Naturally fermented on skins for 4 weeks. Hand plunged 4 times daily during fermentation. Basket pressed to new and old oak for 24 months. 30% new French Oak.

Vineyard

Hickinbotham Vineyard, Clarendon Unknown clone planted on own roots in the 50's 260m-270m elevation, North-Westerly aspect. Clay loam with ironstone gravel over sandstone and siltstone. VSP spur pruned.
