Apple blossom, lychees and a hint of honey.

**Palate**

Zippy, fresh acidity drives the palate, with a soft mousse that works beautifully with the generous mouthfeel.

**Pair**

Sunshine, oysters, sashimi and hard cheeses.

**Winemaking**

Picked in the early morning, 100% destemmed into the press. Gently pressed and racked clean to tank. Wild fermentation at cool temperatures. Matured on lees for 3 months. No MLF. Blended with previous vintage prior to bottling.

**Vineyard**

Meridian Vineyard, Murray Darling / Taylorville, Riverland, SA. For both vineyards: Prosecco on own roots. 50m elevation, no aspect. Reddish sandy loam over limestone. Taylorville, Riverland, SA. VSP Spur pruner on double cordon.
