We don't believe this is the best way to get the most out of grenache – favouring lively acidity, low tannin extraction and drinkability first and foremost. A 'Nouveaux' wine in more ways than one."

Nose

Red fruit, pepper spice and dusty earth.

Palate

Soft and mellow, the acidity is fresh without any sharp edges. Dusky tannins delicately coat the mouth, filled out by a moderate fruit weight and aperitif-like spice.

Pair

Your new favourite series.

Winemaking

Handpicked and machine harvested. 10% whole bunch fermentation. Naturally fermented on skins for 1 week. Gently pumped over twice daily. Matured in stainless for 8 months.

Vineyard

Barmera, Riverland SA 80% / Langhorne Creek, SA 20%. Mix of clones, planted over the previous 30 years. Barmera has red sandy loam over a deep calcareous base / LC has a thin layer of clay loam over limestone. VSP spur pruned.
