Vintage 2022

Variety Pinot Grigio Region Eden Valley

Nose

Pears on the nose with the gentle aroma of baked spices underneath.

Palate

Generous mouthfeel with refreshing acidity that livens up a succulent palate.

Pair

Creamy pasta, mushroom and paté, prosciutto and cured meats.

Winemaking

Harvested at night 100% destemmed and gently pressed to stainless. Fermented at cool temperatures. Maturation in stainless for 12 months. No MLF.

Vineyard

Mountadam Vineyard, Eden Valley. Unknown Clone on own roots. 460m Elevation, E aspect. Sandy loam over clay VSP spur pruned.

"When I think of this grey-skinned variety, I imagine a sliding scale, with fresh and mineral Grigio sitting at one end and the richer sweetness of Gris at the other. The Tarot Pinot G plonks itself firmly in the middle with fresh, crisp pears at the beginning that softens to honeyed baking spices, supported by an element of texture that makes it a more intriguing drink."
